Winter Booking Conditions

1. To make a reservation, having telephoned to check availability the client should complete and sign the booking form and return it together with payment of the initial non-refundable deposit (£80 per person). Following receipt of the booking form and deposit, we will send a confirmation invoice. This is the formal acceptance of the booking.

2. The balance of the invoice is payable not less than 8 weeks before the start of the holiday period. If payment is not received by the due date we reserve the right to give notice in writing that the reservation is cancelled. Reservations made within 8 weeks of the start of the holiday period require full payment at the time of booking.

3. Cancellations must be in writing and will take effect from the day of receipt. In the event of cancellation the following charges will be made:-

Over 8 weeks	deposit only
2-4 weeks	70% of total holiday price
4-6 weeks	50% of total holiday price
6-8 weeks	30% of total holiday price

The client must arrange a comprehensive travel insurance policy (including cancellation cover) and to have full cover for the party's personal belongings, public liability etc.

4. The client agrees to be a considerate tenant, to take good care of the property and to leave it in good condition. We reserve the right to charge for unlawful damage and breakages.

5. The client agrees not to act in any way which would cause disturbance to other guests staying in the chalet or those resident in neighbouring properties.

6. We shall not be liable to the client for:

- any temporary defect or stoppage in the supply of public services to the property, nor in respect of any equipment or appliances.
- any loss, damage or injury which is the result of adverse weather conditions, riot, war or strikes, or other matters beyond our control.
- any loss, damage or inconvenience caused to or suffered by the client if the property is destroyed or substantially damaged before the start of the holiday period.

This contract shall be governed by English law in every particular including formation and interpretation and shall be deemed to have been made in England. Any proceedings arising out of or in connection with this contract may be brought in any court of competent jurisdiction in England.
